Civic education is frequently used in conjunction with other capacity-building and participatory approaches, to strengthen the ability of citizens and civil society groups to organize themselves, interact with others, and make their voices heard by those in power. In achieving SPARCS' fundamental function of advocating for children's participation, the organization affirms that it is crucial to equip children and young people with skills that will enable them to participate in their school communities.
